Staff Fee Charges: Cost per hour, per person – charged to all outside groups:

Site Supervision and Cleanup – Custodial; Kitchen Supervision; Equipment Operation:

\$45 after building hours on weekdays

\$55 with a 4 hour minimum on weekends

Security Charge: \$100 minimum callback charge to secure a facility left open by any user.

For the purposes of carrying out the fee schedule, groups seeking the use of school facilities have been divided into use categories.

GROUP 1

- a. Non-profit Youth clubs, organizations, programs and individuals whose members reside in the City of Mercer Island. Youth organizations when 75% or more of its members reside within the City of Mercer Island. (Does not include MISD affiliated non-profit groups)
- b. Non-profit Adult clubs, organizations, programs and individuals. Adult organizations when 75% or more of its members reside within the City of Mercer Island.

GROUP 2

- a. Non-profit Youth clubs, organizations, programs and individuals when less than 75% of its members reside within the City of Mercer Island.
- b. Non-profit Adult clubs, organizations, programs and individuals, when less than 75% of its members reside within the City of Mercer Island.

GROUP 3

- a. Commercial (for-profit) clubs, organizations, programs and individuals.

Priority for use of the School District facilities:

1. Mercer Island School District Programs
2. Mercer Island School District affiliated non-profit group
3. City of Mercer Island
4. Non-profit local youth organizations
5. For-profit local service and civic organizations and youth activities
6. Organizations or non-local groups whose activities do not directly support or supplement the District's educational program
7. Non-District sponsored or for-profit groups

"Local" means more than 75% of group is Mercer Island residents
