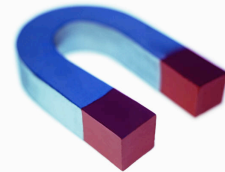

Our goal is to teach children at an early stage the true nature of science: how fun it is to ask questions and answer them yourself!

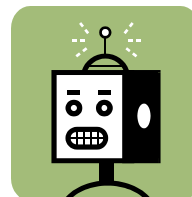

General Rules

PLEASE READ THESE RULES CAREFULLY!

1. Safety is important! Do not begin a project without adult supervision. Adult supervision is required in the use of any chemicals, flames, electricity, animals, poisonous plants, bacteria, fungi or any potentially dangerous equipment.
2. Approval of the SF Committee is required: (1) in the use of people or animals in your experiments.(2) Team projects (more than 2 students)
3. The Display Should:
 - A. Have a project board or poster with project title, your name, school, grade, and a summary of your project (ex. question, experimental design, results, and conclusions).
 - B. Stand independently (not against a wall).
 - C. Cannot be more than 30 inches deep and 48 inches wide (will stand on a 30 inch high table)
 - D. Approval of SF committee is needed to display:
 1. flames or flammables
 2. open liquids
 3. dry ice
 4. open food
 5. animals or their parts
 6. bacteria or fungi
 7. operating equipment
 8. oversize items
4. Students MUST:
 - A. Set up the project at IP multi-purpose on March 4th, 2010 between 4:00 and 5:00 PM.
 - B. Provide all the materials needed to set-up and display project (extension cords, tapes, etc).
 - C. Leave projects on display until 7:45PM.
 - D. Remove project by 8:30 PM. IP PTA and MISD are not responsible for stolen or lost items.
5. Parents MUST:
 - A. Limit your participation in the project to supervision.
 - B. Choose a volunteer position to assist with the operation of MISF event.

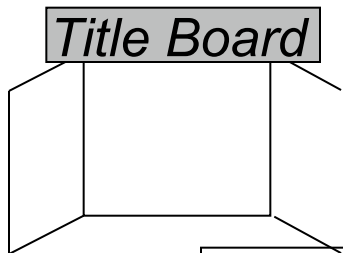
