

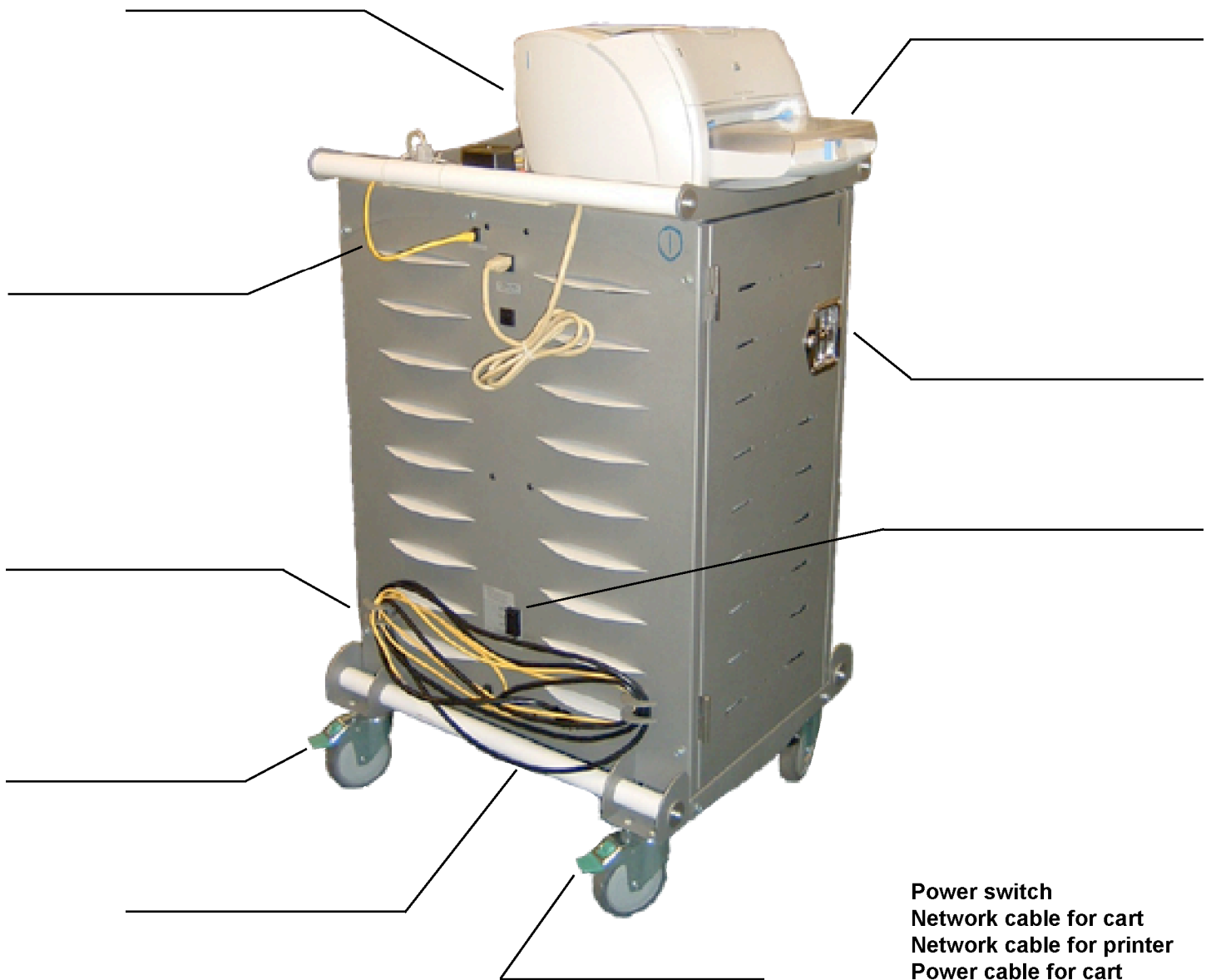
iBook Mobile Carts

Lakeridge Elementary has three Anthro carts. Carts 1 and 2 have ten iBooks; Cart 3 has twenty iBooks. The carts are identified by numbers written on them. Each cart also has a HP LaserJet 1200 with a HP JetDirect card that networks the printer. The iBooks are equipped with an AirPort wireless card that allows the iBooks to use the wireless access points throughout campus. The carts do not have any networking equipment on-board. Network connectivity for the iBooks is provided by the AirPort cards. The cart must be physically plugged into the network to provide connectivity for the printer.
